Understanding Your Levy

The custard apples levy and charge were first introduced 1 January 1995. Custard apples produced in Australia and sold by the producer or that are exported, will attract a levy or charge. Hort Innovation is responsible for the expenditure of the custard apples levy and charge.

Custard apples means a fruit of the species *Annona cherimola*, *Annona muricata*, *Annona reticulata*, *Annona squamosa* or a hybrid between, or within, any of these species.

A producer of custard apples, that is the person who owns the custard apples immediately after harvest, is liable to pay the levy. If a grower of custard apples, sells their fruit through an intermediary, including a first purchaser, buying agent, selling agent, or exporting agent, the amount of levy they pay on behalf of the grower is recovered from the grower.

For example, when a grower receives a grower/remittance advice, outlining the prices received, the levy amount (as per the rates below) is deducted from the final payment. Levy Breakdown

Custard Apples	Research & Development Levy
Packaged – standard box 10 kilograms	40 cents per box
Packaged – standard tray 7 kilograms	40 cents per tray
Bulk	\$50 per tonne
